Imperial County Registrar of Voters Unveils New Department Logo

The new logo adds a red, white, and blue border and wording, reflecting the Registrar of Voter's commitment to the American electoral process, while incorporating the County seal intended to give a unified identity with the County and all other departments.

"As the newly appointed Registrar it seemed appropriate at this time to enliven the department's previous monochrome logo that had been used for decades," stated Registrar Linsey Dale, "In addition to our new look, we are also planning technological upgrades to the department that will increase our staff's efficiencies while providing more conveniences and transparency for the voters."
