June 15, 2021 – The County of Imperial is proud to partner with the California Department of Insurance (CDI) to host an Insurance & Economic Recovery Resources Virtual Town Hall with California Insurance Commissioner Ricardo Lara and District 5 Supervisor Ray Castillo on Thursday, July 8, 2021, at 1:30 p.m. on Zoom.
