Some of the duties include, but are not limited to the following:

- The initial board of directors shall create a staggered board of directors by choosing several board members to remain on the board following the first district election occurring pursuant to subdivision (a) of Section 32499.7;
- The initial board of directors, in collaboration with the Imperial County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO), shall determine the years that the voting districts and associated board positions will be up for election by July 1, 2024;
- The initial board of directors shall recommend a permanent funding source mechanism to be presented to and approved by voters via ballot measure;
- The initial board of directors shall enter negotiations with the El Centro Regional Medical Center to decide the terms of the acquisition of the hospital;
- The initial board of directors shall finalize the terms of acquiring the hospital by November 5, 2024;
- The initial board of directors shall recommend to the Imperial County LAFCO a date for the dissolution of the Pioneers Memorial Healthcare District and Heffernan Memorial Healthcare District;
- The board of directors shall hold a minimum of three public meetings between the effective date of this chapter and January 1, 2025; and
- Additional responsibilities accordingly.

Please note that "a member of the initial board of directors, appointed pursuant to Section 32499.6 of AB 918, shall not be eligible to become an elected board member of the district for the first round of elections for each respective board seat."
