Hope all is well and you're in full holiday mode. We're in a good position share and discuss the Lithium Valley Specific Plan water demands again with IID. Could you please confirm whether the following statement and quantities are still accurate as this was from March 2024?

With regards to the Interim Water Supply Policy (IWSP, 2009), IID has issued two water supply agreements and one "Will-Serve Letter" under the IWSP for 6,380 AFY, leaving a balance of 18,620 AFY of potential water supply available for additional conservation and contracting under the IWSP.
